Minutes

A meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Colfax County, Nebraska was held in the Commissioners Room of the County Courthouse, Schuyler, Nebraska on the 28th day of February 2023. The County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 a.m. Present were: Carl Grotelueschen, Jim Mejstrik and Terry V. Wendt, County Commissioners, Rita M. Mundil, County Clerk and Bruce J. Prenda, County Attorney. Notice of this meeting was given in advance thereof by posting written notice in at least three different public places as shown by the Certificate of Posting Notice. The availability of the proposed agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the board. Copies of the Open Meetings Act were posted and available to the public. All proceedings shown were taken while the meeting was officially convened and open to the public.

The chairman stated a copy of the Open Meeting Act statute is posted and available to the public.

Motion Mejstrik; second Wendt to approve the agenda. Voting YES: Grotelueschen, Mejstrik and Wendt. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

Motion Grotelueschen; second Wendt to approve the regular minutes of 2/14/2023. Voting YES: Mejstrik, Wendt and Grotelueschen. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

The clerk provided the fund balances, December Lodging Tax Revenue, STOP Revenue received, 2022 fuel refund, National Opioids Settlement Funds received and NIRMA's 2022 Annual report.

The inmate logs from Butler and Platte County were provided to the board and placed on file.

The 4th quarter CASA report was provided to the board.

The county attorney reported there are new national opioid settlements which have been reached with Teva, Allergan, CVS, Walgreens, and Walmart. Colfax County will need to submit a participation form for each settlement on or before April 18, 2023.

The commissioners discussed the American Rescue Planning Act (ARPA) funding. Howells Rural Fire Protection District has submitted receipts of \$56,116.85 for consideration of reimbursement of fire and safety equipment they have purchased. Motion Grotelueschen; second Mejstrik to approve \$56,116.85 from the COVID Rescue Plan fund to the Howells Rural Fire Protection District. Voting YES: Wendt, Grotelueschen and Mejstrik. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

The board reviewed the information sheets on LegalShield, IDShield, VSP Vision Care and Supplemental Life Insurance for optional benefits available for Colfax County employees. These optional benefits will be at the employee's expense. Motion Wendt; second Mejstrik to approve VSP Vision Care as an optional benefit for Colfax County employees with an effective date of July 1, 2023; this optional benefit will be at the employee's own expense. Voting YES: Grotelueschen, Mejstrik and Wendt. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

LegalShield, IDShield, and Supplemental Life Insurance are services that will not be made available to Colfax County employees.

Motion Grotelueschen; second Mejstrik to approve the following claims and issue checks for them with the exception of Department of Corrections in the amount of \$2,800.85. Voting YES: Mejstrik, Wendt and Grotelueschen. Voting NO: None. Motion carried.

The Zoning administrator reported that she will be meeting with Keith Marvin/Zoning Consultant to review the zoning regulations that were last updated eight years ago. The Board of Adjustments will have its yearly meeting on March 15, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. The Planning and Zoning meeting with follow at 7:00 p.m. with a public hearing to be held. The Planning and Zoning board members spoke in support of a longer work week for their zoning administrator, instead of a 35-hour work week to be allowed a 40-hour work week. The board directed the zoning administrator that she is allowed to work up to a 40-hour work week when necessary. After the completion of reviewing the zoning regulation her scheduled hours will go back to the 35-hour work week.

A letter of support for the grant application of Stealth Broadband to receive the Public Service Commission, Nebraska Broadband Bridge Program (NBBP) Capital Projects Fund (CPF) grant was reviewed.

The public hearing for the proposed One- & Six-Year Plan for Highway Improvement for Colfax County for 2023 was moved to March 14, 2023 at 10:30 a.m.

Lucas Luckey/Big Iron Auctions was present to answer any questions regarding placing a motor grader at their auction.

The highway superintendent gave a report of the activities of his department; an update of road/bridge projects was given. Two bid lettings will be held on March 28, 2023: 1) at 10:15 a.m. will be the bid letting for "Colfax County Aggregate Hauling" 2) at 10:30 will be the bid letting for Shell Creek Bridge Project C19 (555). Nebraska Department of Transportation provided information on how to review transportation projects in the STIP and Nebraska Surface Transport Book online.

The county clerk summarized the day's agenda and action taken.
